1. General Information

1.1 Host city location

Kaposvár is situated in the southwest of Hungary which lies on the banks of the Kapos river. It is a major Transdanubian city, the county seat of Somogy, having roughly 70.000 residents. It is only a 2 hour drive (180 km) from the capital, Budapest. The lake Balaton, so called "Hungarian sea" - the largest lake in Eastern Europe is very near, about 50 kms.

Water temperature 26C° ± 1C°



2. Tournament details

2.1 Eligibility

Each club must be associated with a National Federation recognized by World Aquatics. All competitors must have a federal card, a competitive Sport Medical Certificate for the current season and a photocopy of an identity document. Each participant should respect the championship rules, the safety requirements set by the organizers. The competition will be conducted in accordance with the regulations of MÚSZ (Hungarian Swimming Federation).

Women E - Women's E age group from 2016 to 2016

Women F - Women's F age group from 2017 to 2017

2.4 Judges

Head of the Competition Jury: Béla Vargha

The judges will be determined on the basis of a subsequent appointment.

2.5 Other conditions for participation

- 1) A competitor can only start in the races of one age group.
- 2) All competitors participate in the competition at their own risk.
- 3) The race and start list for the competitors will be generated by the Omega program based on the best times in the register. This program during whole competition.
- 4) During this event filming, photography and broadcasting may take place. By attending this event you grant permission to be included in pictures and/or on film and their advertising, without compensation or credit.

2.6 Rankings, appraisals

The ranking order is determined by the time results achieved during the heats. In each event, the competitors with the best times participate in the first heat. Rankings are based on times from the heats. Age groups will be evaluated separately.

The first three places in "A", "B", "C", "D", "E", "F", "G" and the "Open" categories will receive a medal. Age groups "E," "F," and "G" (places 4-6) will receive a diploma.

2.7 Protest

The protest may be submitted in writing within 30 minutes after the publication of the results. The protest fee is 10 000 HUF which will be refunded if justified. The protest is decided by the head of the competition.

4. Costs

The costs of the organization are covered by the organizers, and the costs of the participants (starts, accommodation, meals, travel, etc...) are covered by the clubs themselves. Spectators, parents must pay an entrance fee of HUF 400/person at the cash desk. They can enter through the main entrance.

5. General Conditions

- The competition will be organized with one start!
- The Organizers reserve the right to make any changes if an unforeseen event occurs. The organizers will notify the participants of any changes in time.

5.1 Visa Requirements

If you require visas please contact the nearest Hungarian Embassy or Consular Office to your country of residence. In order to facilitate the visa process please send list of participants with names, birth dates and passport numbers to the tournament e-mail address, as soon as you would know your teams' athletes' names and accompanying persons so that we can supply you with the necessary invitation letters. Visa arrangements should start not later than three months prior to entry into Hungary.
